Persistently At-Risk and At-Risk Students

K-3:

81 “Persistently at Risk” students, 82 “At Risk”

4-6:

60 “Persistently At Risk” students, 24 “At Risk”

Clarinda Compared to Peers (Fall 2021 scores)

Clarinda	58%
Green Hills AEA area	64%
Iowa	63%

Kindergarten Data to Note

- In the fall of 2019 **78%** of Kindergarten students scored proficient
- In the fall of 2020 **75%** of Kindergarten students scored proficient
- In the fall of 2021 **54%** of Kindergarten students scored proficient

Possible factors: Pandemic, home learning, and changes in local preschool services (closing of Clarinda Community, ½ versus full day, etc.)

Students Currently Served in Title I Reading

Kindergarten: **3** persistently at risk students, **14** at risk students

1st Grade: **26** persistently at risk students

2nd Grade: **24** persistently at risk students

3rd Grade: **15** persistently at risk students

- Per ELL law, K-3 students who are identified as persistently at risk are required to receive intervention in addition to core instruction
- At risk students with a reading IEP receive their interventions in the Special Education classroom and are not included in the numbers above
