PREGNANT STUDENTS

The board encourages pregnant students to continue to attend the education program as long as they are physically able to do so. The pregnant student <u>is encouraged to may</u> notify the principal or the guidance counselor as soon as <u>she is they are</u> aware of the pregnancy <u>in order for the district to facilitate the student's equal access to the district's education programs and activities.</u> The school may require that a pregnant student provide the principal with a written note from her <u>their</u> doctor relative to special conditions that might exist and specific suggestions as to how long the student may continue to attend classes. If the student is unable to attend school because of her <u>their</u> pregnancy, the student may be excused and arrangements made to continue her studies during her <u>their</u> absence. The student will resume classes upon the recommendation of her <u>their</u> physician.
