Service Type: At-Risk and Returning/Potential Dropout

Service Focus: Academic, Personal, Career, Attendance, and Credit Accrual/Passing Grades

Service Description: The Clarinda Community School Districts provides mentoring, individual counseling, small group counseling, and academic planning and support to students facing challenges in one or more of the following areas that may lead to a student dropping out of school. Academic, Performance, Reading and/or Math Scores, Personal or Social Problems, Attendance, Behavioral Problems, or Family/Home Life Issues, and School Connectivity.

Service Evaluation: Students in the program are monitored throughout the school year. Information is shared with teachers and staff. District administration and staff evaluate the effectiveness of the program based on the numbers of students served, and the progress students make during the course of the school year, and from year to year.

Data Collection Procedures: Data is collected and monitored by staff through the student information system including attendance, discipline, and academic performance.
