4. SiteLogiQ Discussion and Information

The survey shows top recommendations include safety/security and renovating Family Consumer Science/CTE rooms along with the community willing to have a \$10-12 monthly increase in taxes. Gilbert Thomas, community group member, reported 15 community members took part in listening and asking questions about the SAVE, voted PPEL, and General Obligation bond. More District communication is encouraged about student and staff goals and accomplishments. The recommendation to the Board is up to a \$2.00 GO bond for 20 years. Others from the community group encouraged the Board and staff to communicate the needs and whys of passing a bond.
