RESOLUTION FOR A CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published as required by law, the Board of Directors of the Clarinda Community School District on the 9th day of August, 2023 held a hearing on the proposal to convey an interest in real property and the extent of objections received from residents or property owners as to said proposed transaction has been fully considered; and, accordingly the following action is now considered to be in the best interests of the District and residents thereof:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CLARINDA COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Section 1. That the real property described herein shall be conveyed by the District to Clarinda Carnegie Museum for \$421,000.00 and other good and valuable consideration. Conveyance by the District shall be by Deed without Warranty.

Section 2. The Board President and Secretary are authorized to sign all conveyance documents for the real property described herein.

Section 3. The Board President, Secretary, Superintendent, and administrative officers of the District are authorized to take all actions necessary to complete the above-described transaction, including execution of ancillary documents.

Section 4. The real property is locally known as 1180 S. 16th Street, Clarinda, IA 51632, and is legally described as follows:
